## **EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2014**

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife annually adjusts its filing fees pursuant to Fish and Game Code Sections 711.4 and 713. Therefore, as of January 1, 2014, the Planning Department will begin collecting the following modified filing fees in the instances described below:

- Projects for which a Negative Declaration or Mitigated Negative Declaration is prepared require a filing fee of <u>\$2,181.25</u> (an increase of \$25.00).
- Projects for which an Environmental Impact Report is prepared require a filing fee of \$3,029.75 (an increase of \$34.50).

In addition, in accordance with County Ord. No. 729.6, a <u>\$50.00</u> Document Handling Fee is required to be paid to the County Clerk. Proof of payment of the appropriate filing fees, together with the Document Handling Fee, must be provided to the County Clerk at the time of filing the Notice of Determination.

Payment of the appropriate fees will be required for Planning projects that have been approved, but not had a Notice of Determination filed with the County Clerk prior to January 1, 2014; or for Planning projects that will be approved within the 2014 calendar year, and have a Notice of Determination filed with the County Clerk's office before December 31, 2014.

Payment of said fees will be required prior to receiving a recommendation of approval of a Planning project.

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
