FILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTAL OF PLANNING GEOLOGIC REPORT (GEO/SSR)

The following instructions are intended to provide the necessary information and procedures to facilitate the processing of a Geological Report application. Cooperation with these instructions will insure that the application can be processed in the most expeditious manner possible.

THE GEOLOGIC REPORT (GEO/SSR) SUBMITTAL APPLICATION FILING PACKAGE MUST CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. A completed and signed application form.
- 2. A complete, original, wet-signed copy of Geologic Report (Fault Report, Liquefaction Report, Geotechnical/Geologic Report, or Slope Stability Report).
- 3. A complete, original, wet-signed copy of Preliminary Methane Investigation Report (as appropriate), if applicable.
- 4. A copy of the most current entitlement case exhibit or map (Tract Map, Tentative Parcel Map, Plot Plan, Use Permit, etc.). Note: The submitted Report must be based on the most current map or exhibit that is under consideration for that entitlement.
- 5. Digital copies of the all the above listed items in a format acceptable to the Planning Department (e.g. PDF).
- 6. Initial payment of deposit-based fees for a Slope Stability Report. (Review of SSR will be charged to the implementing application).

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
