## 1. PLANNING AREA 1 — Phase I Golf Course

## a. <u>Descriptive Summary</u>

Planning Area 1 consists of approximate 6,700 yard Championship 18-hole golf course. The golf course will be the initial stage of Phase I of development. The golf course is laid out in a linear fashion which will allow maximum frontage of residential lots along the golf course. Golf cart paths will also meander throughout the golf course. The golf course may not be used for walking or jogging due to safety considerations. Phase I golf course will also include golf course supporting facilities, including a driving range which can be used as an outdoor amphitheater.

Planning Area 1 will also function as part of the site's drainage system, the lakes on the golf course will serve as a part of the landscape irrigation water system. See Sections IV.A.3 and IV.A.5.

Planning Area 1 will be a common area. The golf course will be deeded to the Master Association prior to sale of the homes, and will be operated by the Homeowners Association.
