The Applicant is proposing to construct, operate and decommission an up to 650 MW solar PV electrical generation facility and battery energy storage system, and associated infrastructure to generate and deliver renewable electricity to the statewide electricity transmission grid. The renewable energy facility sites would occupy approximately 990 acres on privately-owned land and 2,745 acres of BLM-administered land. A 6.7-mile 500 kilovolt gen-tie line would connect into an approved substation on the adjacent Oberon Renewable Energy Project. From the Oberon onsite substation, the power generated by the Easley Project would be transmitted to the electrical grid at the SCE Red Bluff Substation. The BLM will prepare and rely on its own environmental review document in accordance with National Environmental Policy Act.
