NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

A PUBLIC HEARING has been scheduled, pursuant to Riverside County Land Use Ordinance No. 348, before the **RIVERSIDE COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION** to consider a proposed project, as described below.

PROJECT CASE NO.: Conditional Use Permit No. 230006 (CUP230006)

APPLICANT: Marianne Cordova Breen (Corion Capital Partners, LLC) represented by Lindsey Engels (Arclogica Architects)

PROJECT LOCATION: The proposed Project site is located north of Brookside Avenue, south of Cherry Valley Boulevard, east of Nancy Avenue and west of Mountain View Avenue. The site abuts the City of Beaumont to the south and east. The Project site encompasses Assessor's Parcel Numbers: 405-230-002, 405-230-006, and 405-230-010

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Conditional Use Permit No. 230006 to establish a "self-storage and recreational vehicle storage facility" (miniwarehouse) comprised of 10 single-story buildings (ranging in size between 5,060 square-feet and 24,930 square-feet), one single-story administration building (measuring 1,365 square-feet in area), and five detached permanent canopies for the storage of



150 recreational vehicles. The project will be conditioned to require a Lot Line Adjustment (to be processed administratively under separate submittal) between parcels APN: 405-230-002, 405-230-006, and 405-230-010 (totaling 18.44-acres) to create two sites - one of which is the Project site at 8.27-acres - coupled with demolition of the existing structures located at APN's 405-230-006 and 405-230-010. The existing residence located at APN 405-230-002 will remain.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The County of Riverside has prepared an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration in accordance with California Environmental Quality Act

(CEQA) Guidelines Section 15070. The Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration represents the County's independent judgment and analysis. Based upon the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration, the proposed Project will not have a significant effect on the environment with the implementation of mitigation measures. Further, the County did not identify any significant, unavoidable impacts that require further analysis in an Environmental Impact Report.

PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD: April 18^h, 2024 - May 8, 2024

The IS/MND is being circulated for a review period pursuant to State Law. You may participate remotely by registering with the Planning Department. All comments received prior to the public hearing will be submitted to the Planning Commission for consideration, in addition to any oral testimony, before making a decision on the proposed project. All correspondence received before and during the meeting will be distributed to the Planning Commission and retained for the official record.

If this project is challenged in court, the issues may be limited to those raised at the public hearing, described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Director at, or prior to, the public hearing. Be advised that as a result of public hearings and comment, the Planning Commission may amend, in whole or in part, the proposed project. Accordingly, the designations, development standards, design or improvements, or any properties or lands within the boundaries of the proposed project, may be changed in a way other than specifically proposed.
