Activities will include a brief presentation and group activities to discuss necessary improvements along Highway 74. Light food and refreshments may be served for attendees.

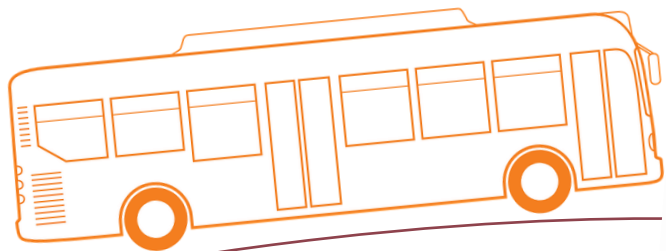
