## FILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR A PALEONTOLOGICAL REPORT REVIEW

The following instructions are intended to provide the necessary information and procedures to facilitate the processing of a Paleontological Report Review application. Cooperation with these instructions will ensure that the application can be processed in the most expeditious manner possible.

## FILING INSTRUCTIONS CHECKLIST

A PALEONTOLOGICAL REPORT REVIEW FILING PACKAGE MUST CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

Digital copies of the following items below in a format acceptable to the Planning Department (e.g., PDF).

- 1. A completed General Application Form.
- 2. A completed and signed Applicant-Property Owner Signature Form.
- 3. A completed Paleontological Report Review Supplemental Information form.
- 4. A completed and signed Paleontological Report.
- 5. A copy of the most current entitlement exhibit or tentative map (Tentative Tract Map, Tentative Parcel Map, Plot Plan, Use Permit, etc.). Note: The submitted Report must be based on the most current map or exhibit that is under consideration for that entitlement.
